



#### **ADMISSION:**

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

#### **B.A.LL.B.** (5 Year Law Course)

Academic qualification – Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (10+2) or its equivalent with 45% marks. There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in case of SC/ST students within the state of Maharashtra. Non-Zero Score in MAH-LLB-5 CET will not be eligible for the admission.

Applicants who have obtained 10+2 higher secondary pass certificate or first-degree certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method are eligible for admission in the integrated five-year course.

Applicants who have obtained 10+2 or graduation / post-graduation through open universities system, directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are NOT ELIGIBLE for admission in law course.

#### LL.B. (3 Year Law Course)

Academic qualification – A student passing a Bachelor's degree examination with Minimum 45% Marks in any faculty of this University or any other Recognized University shall be eligible for admission to the First year LL.B. Course (three-year degree course). There shall be relaxation of 5% marks in case of SC/ST students. Non-Zero Score in MAH-LLB-3 CET will not be eligible for the admission.

Students, faculty members, and scholars are encouraged to recommend as many books of international standards as are required by them. The library is open to students during college hours. The timing for issuing the books is between 08:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. We also have Central Library of Sri Balaji Society, Pune which contains all international books, reference books related to the courses, management, and international scenario with spacious and well-furnished reading hall.


